

## How to pre-populate Break-Out Rooms in Zoom

You may want to allocate your student cohort into Breakout Rooms prior to your online session. This may be because you want students to re-use the groups week after week (help students develop working relationships) or because you want to curate the Breakout Room groups to ensure a good mix of students (gender splits, home vs overseas etc..)

Alternatively, you may just want to randomly assign students to groups each week and this is very simple to do on-the-fly. You can of course allocate specific students into specific groups on-the-fly but for larger classes this will be very time consuming so pre-defining the groups will be a big advantage.

### How to Pre-Define Break-Out Groups and add students

**Participants (students) must be signed into a University Zoom account and using the Zoom app rather than the web browser to access the session.** If these conditions are met it is possible to pre-assign participants to breakout rooms in advance of a zoom session.

To ensure this process works you should inform students to download the zoom app (using their university email account) in advance of teaching activities.

To pre-define the Breakout Rooms you will need a list of all the email addresses of your students.

#### Step 1 – Request List of cohort email addresses

Your discipline Teaching and Learning office will be able to supply you with an excel file listing all your students by email address. This information should be transferred person-to-person in a GDPR compliant way.

**You must make this request at least 5 working days before your Zoom session in order to give staff the time to create this spreadsheet.**

#### Step 2 – Open file in Excel and add Room names

Once you have received an excel spreadsheet containing the student names you can now add another column and move it to column 1 (Column 2 should now be the column of student emails). Add the title of your Breakout Rooms into Column 1.

Your spreadsheet should like this...

Save the spreadsheet as a .csv file

### Step 3 – Access your Zoom account

Sign in to your Zoom account at <https://zoom.us/signin>

You will now need to schedule the zoom session you want to allocate the pre-defined groups to.

Click on **Meetings** and then **Schedule a Meeting**, entering the relevant dates and time and set-up information. In the meeting Options section tick the box **Breakout Room pre-assign**. Select the **Import From CSV** option and upload your previously saved csv file.
