Adding Adaptive release to your Blackboard Test

This guide explains how to control the release of content in Blackboard using the **Adaptive Release** features of Blackboard. You can use **Adaptive Release** to restrict students from seeing content until it is appropriate for them to have access to it.

There are several ways to attach Adaptive Release data to a Blackboard test or Item. This guide will use the specific example of applying adaptive release dates to a Blackboard test.

We recommend that you add the dates and times for release using the **Edit The Test Options** page.


In the **Test Availability** section you will see the **Display After** and **Display Until** options. These are the dates and times that control the visibility of your test.

After you have selected your required dates, ensure you enable Make available to students. You can do this in the Test Options.

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This will highlight the rule that is being followed, e.g. item is hidden from students. It will be available after [date] [time].



In the above screenshot the first test has been made **Available to Students** and its visibility will be triggered by the Adaptive Release dates.

The second test has NOT been made **Available to Students** and so will NOT become visible to students, regardless of any adaptive release information.
